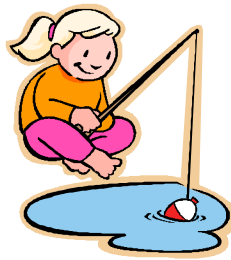

Kids Fishing Contest

Check-in: 9 a.m. at the clubhouse. **You can begin fishing as soon as you check in! Fish until 11 a.m.**

An award will be presented to the child who catches the biggest fish! There will also be an award for the one who catches the most fish!

Rules:

1. Each participant is required to bring his/her own fishing equipment including a bucket to hold their catch. To ensure fish health, organizers will canvas the area to make sure all are in compliance.
2. Any child of an owner or guest 12 years of age and under can participate.
3. Kids under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
4. There are no restrictions on the type of bait used.
5. The amount of help given by an accompanying adult is limited. The adults can only help with setting up the fishing equipment i.e. tying of a hook on a fishing line.
6. The participants will be fishing from the shore in the immediate clubhouse area. **NO FISHING ON THE BEACH!**

Each registered participant will receive a ticket for a "free" lunch. Additional lunches for non-participants can be purchased for \$2.

Morning Water Aerobics

We will again run two sessions of morning water aerobics, back to back this summer!

The first session will begin on Tuesday, June 14th at 9 a.m.

This is a four week session, with classes three days per week on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. You get 12 one hour classes!

The cost for the session is the same as last year, \$30 for members or \$50 for non-members. Our fees are set low just to cover the cost of the instructor.

The first session of classes ends on July 7th.

The class is open to anyone 12 and older, and to both males and females. (Though we haven't had any males join us yet!)

You may sign up and prepay at the Association office during regular business hours (preferred—it helps us to plan!). Or, simply show up a few minutes early on the first day of class and sign up and pay then.

The second session will run from July 12th thru August 4th.

If you sign up and prepay by June 14th for both morning sessions, we will discount your fee to \$50 for members and \$90 for non-members. This discount is good only if you prepay in full for both classes by June 14th.

If you can't commit to both by the above date, you can still sign up for each session on an individual basis for the regular fee of \$30/\$50 each.

We are hoping to also schedule an evening class in August. Watch for more details in the next newsletter, or on the website.

As in the past, if you can't commit to an entire session, you may bring a friend or "drop in" on a casual one-time basis for \$5 per class hour at any of the regularly scheduled classes.

These are easy and fun exercises that anyone can do. "Drop -ins" never have a problem following the exercises. Please join us anytime you can!

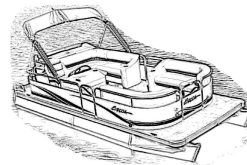
